

- 7.00pm *The evening starts with us travelling to the venue. The team meet and the lead investigator takes the head of the convoy. Nobody knows apart from the Lead Investigator where we are heading!!*
- 8.00pm *We arrive at the venue and unload all the technical equipment, this normally consists of webcams, hub equipment, cameras, paranormal investigation equipment and most importantly the tea and coffee box!*
- 8.30pm *As lead investigator, I am also the technical manager so I coordinate the setting up of all the equipment. We have a wireless hub so we don't have miles of cables but we still have to locate the cameras to catch as much as possible. We also lock off a room with motion detection cameras so this need trigger objects and a lockable door!*
- 9.00pm *All the equipment is now setup and the laptops working and recording live feeds. I am tired so I ask Rob, our Medium to do the safety walk-round and risk assessment with the team while I put my feet up for a while!!!!*
- 9.30pm *Rob has done the walk round and I have double checked and re-positioned 2 cameras, it's a quick break and investigation time! At the end of the break Rob talks everybody through spiritual protection and I give a give talk on teams and where the cameras are located, I want to ensure we don't catch people picking their nose!*

- 9.45pm *We have divided into 3 teams, and we have positioned a team member in the hub to monitor the cameras. The 4 cameras have been projected onto a wall so the cameras are much easier to check. Rob and I are moving around each of the groups checking that everything is OK. Group 1 are undertaking glass divination, Group 2 are calling out and sitting quietly and Group 3 are trying to communicate through crystals and our specially designed crystal holder.*
- 10.05pm *We have had a call from the Hub via our walkie talkies, Room 3 with Group 1 are experiencing some amazing glass movement so we head there with additional cameras and equipment.*
- 10.10pm *The glass is moving around the table very quickly and we are rotating the team so ensure one of the team is not pushing the glass by accident. We record the answers to the questions and this will form the report. The hand held cameras are recording the action and we capturing lots of orbs, these are very slow moving and in the same direction so they are probably dust!!*
- 10.30pm *The hub calls break time and we all head down to have a brew and plan our next investigation.*
- 10.45pm *Investigation 2 - we swap around the team and rooms and a new team head to Room 3 to see if they can continue with the glass divination.*

- 11.00pm We receive a call from the Hub, the glass divination is getting better and they are getting some information which mirrors the previous group. I left the camera rolling during the break so I can cross check the findings.
- 11.20pm One of the team in Room 1 has had a stone thrown at them. The team are a bit concerned about safety so I tell them to head to another room and we can head there with the whole team and cameras.
- 11.30pm Break time and I gather in all the notes from each team leader. We all plan the next stage of the investigation.
- 11.45pm The whole team (apart from the Hub monitor) head towards Room 1, the scene of the stone throwing. I examine the room for loose stones and we start the vigil. We have cameras all over the place to try and catch any stones.
- 12.05am No stones but some amazing banging on the floor, we are actually communicating to a spirit!
- 12.30am we head back to the hub
- 12.45am The whole team decide to undertake glass divination, scrying, crystals and dowsing rods experiments. We hope to communicate through all mediums at the same time.
- 12.55am I leave the team and start taking the equipment down.
- 01.45 End of the investigation....
